The Results!



Thorn Creek Audubon birders headed out on December 16 for our 52nd year supporting this annual National Audubon community science project. Results are reported to National Audubon Society and the University of Illinois for ongoing comparisons year to year to assess the health of bird populations and help guide conservation action.

TCAS count coordinator AI Thomas reports: Our 20 volunteers/observers formed 10 teams to count all the birds staying for winter in the official Thorn Creek Audubon count circle - 7.5-mile radius circle centered at Governors State University in University Park. Our birders walked 20 miles and drove 408 miles looking for birds. Rain persisted most of the day, but our diligent teams were still able to tally 52 species of birds and 8990 total individuals.



Calling all birders—the 27th annual Great Backyard Bird Count starts Feb 16! Whether you're a budding birdwatcher or a bird-count veteran, you can use your ID skills to help scientists protect birds and the places they need.

The event is a joint project of Cornell Lab of Ornithology, National Audubon, and Birds Canada. All checklists submitted become part of the massive database used by scientists to track changes in bird populations over time.
