We have worked closely with **Possibility Place Nursery** to choose plants that can be reliably provided. However, even with careful planning, some plants do not propagate as expected and so are not available at the time of pick-up. Unavailable plants will be substituted with appropriate plants.

Native plants are much more likely to thrive when placed where conditions support them: For example, do you love **red**? Both the Cardinal Flower and Royal Catchfly produce beautiful red flowers in sun to partial shade, but the Cardinal Flower likes **wet** conditions, whereas the Royal Catchfly likes **dry** conditions.
